According to a Supreme Arbitration Court Plenum Resolution, RF citizens may bring antimonopoly suits to court without applying to the Federal Antimonopoly Service.

Official publication of documents

The following normative acts have been officially published:

- Federal Law No. 113-FZ of 14 July 2008 “On making changes to Article 18 of the Federal Law “On licensing certain types of activity”” (see our report of 07/15/2008), coming into effect on the day of its official publication;
- Federal Law No. 118-FZ of 14 July 2008 “On making changes to the Russian Federation Water Code and certain legislative acts of the Russian Federation” (see our report of 07/16/2008), coming into effect on the day of its official publication, except for item 8 of Article 1 and Article 17, coming into effect on 1 January 2009;
- Order of the Federal Service for State Statistics No. 61 of 18 March 2008 “On the approval of the Administrative Regulation for the Federal Service for State Statistics to perform the state function of “Providing the official statistical information to the Russian Federation President, the Russian Federation Federal Assembly, the Russian Federation Government, other federal state authorities, the Russian Federation regional state authorities, local government authorities, courts, public prosecution authorities, the Bank of Russia, state non-budget funds, trade unions and employers’ unions, as well as international organizations””;
- RF Government Resolution No. 528 of 15 July 2008 “On the prolongation of the validity term for the import customs duty rate for integral monolithic digital chips,” coming into effect on 15 July 2008.
